
Parking Information



OPTION

The Elmer Lewis Parkette is located a block away from the theatre and a 6-minute walk from the theatre. Parking is FREE in the parkette.







Arriving at Lighthouse

Print and Scan

STEPS

Have the tickets that you printed ready and move forward to the ticket scanning station shown by a star in the photo above.

Pick up and Scan

STEPS

To pick up and scan

- 1. Visit the box office, and tell them your name and the number of tickets you booked.
- 2. There may be a line, so please wait patiently.
- 3. Move forward to the ticket scanning station shown by a star in the photo above.

Getting to the theatre

The theatre is on floor 2, you have the option to use the elevator or stairs. Front of house staff will support you if needed.



Located on the right side of the main hallway, past the lobby of the theatre.

Stairs INFORMATION

At the end of the main hallway, turn to the right and there are over 20 stairs to climb, with hand rails on both sides of the stairs.

Floor 2: The Long Bar

Once on floor 2 you will find yourself in the Long Bar.

Depending on the time you will have to wait to enter the theatre. In the long bar, you can do the following things:

- sit and chat
- listen to music
- read the program
- buy a drink
- buy an ice cream
- or visit the 'chill zone'

The Chill Zone

a quiet place to sit blankets and activities available during the show and at intermission

Theatre Seating Options

The theatre opens 30 minutes before the show, you will have the option to move to your seat(s) at that time.

Theatre staff will be available to help you get to your seat if needed.

Main Floor

Enter the main floor of the theatre where the star is shown in the photo above.





Balcony

Enter the balcony of the theatre where the star is shown in the photo above.

Please note: over 20 narrow stairs to climb

DEVICES



Hearing devices increase the show's sound for users by placing the headset over their ears.

How to reserve a device?

Attendees are welcome to sign out a hearing device when booking tickets online. To do this, add a note before completing the seat reservation.

Please note: quantity is limited

There are two accessible seating options listed below.

Remain seated in your mobility device during the performance using seat numbers 9 and 10 in rows A-E on the main floor.

Sitting in a theatre seat, brought a mobility aid for support you want to reserve seat numbers

- seats 1 and 8 A-E in section 4
- seats 11 in sections 1, and 2,3

Please note: part of section 2 is on a slope

Washroom Options

Washrooms are available on floors 1 and 2. Below the details of the washrooms are listed for your review.





General Washrooms

IN LONG BAR

Gender washrooms are available on Floor 2 on the left side (blue wall) of the long bar.


Accessible Washroom

BESIDE LOBBY

A universal and accessible washroom is available on Floor 1 just past the lobby on the right-hand side of the main hallway, before the elevator.

Exiting the Theatre

Guests are welcome to exit the theatre during intermission for fresh air



Market Street

OPTION

At the side of the theatre on Market Street. There is a side exit available at the base of the stairs.



Main Street

OPTION

At the front of the theatre on Main Street through the theatre lobby.
